This month I have the honor of writing about Kyle Patat, one of our life recovery program graduates. I'm always amazed to get to watch what could only be categorized as divine transformation happen right before my eyes.



Kyle came to the Rescue Mission, like most, weary, beat down by life, and wounded. What has always stood out to me about Kyle is his hunger for something more, something better, something new. Kyle was hungry for recovery, and this hunger has carried on well after his graduation from the program into his daily life as he wrestles well with traversing the difficulties that life tends to throw our way. His time in the program wasn't a cakewalk, as he would probably tell you about the many obstacles he faced as he began to embrace his new life in Christ. There's a lot of things I could sit here and write about Kyle, but I've always admired his honesty and his willingness to learn. Through my time with this mighty man of God, I've personally seen God take Kyle and mold him into a caring and compassionate leader. Kyle has served others in his role of resident manager, while in the program, and after his graduation, he continued serving his brothers in recovery by volunteering his time to drive to outside ministries and facilitate weekly bible studies, which he still makes time to do. The biggest question on a man's mind as he nears the completion of the program is "what's next for me? What's my next move?" For Kyle, his next big step was becoming a permanent part of our team here at the Rescue Mission of Georgia where he was given the opportunity to step into the Assistant Warehouse Manager position at the Bargain Center on Napier Avenue. Kyle never shirked at the challenges he faced as a new staff member; I'm sure he'd describe this differently than I am. We got to see Kyle grow in character,
