RESIDENT TESTIMONY

I feel like I had a decent childhood, until I reached my early teen years. It was during this time in my life that I started hanging around people that were a bad influence on me and full of negativity. I started experimenting with drugs and alcohol, and it quickly escalated from there. My parents worked a lot, so I was able to hide my drug use from them for a while at least. Before I knew it, I was using on a regular basis and had become a full-blown addict. I found myself doing anything I could to feed my addiction. I developed such a strong dependence on using to get me through the day. In my mind, I couldn't make it through the day without using. My entire life revolved around my addiction. I didn't realize it at the time, but I was really using my addiction to numb the shame and guilt I was carrying from my past. I was a manipulative person that would lie and do whatever it took to keep my addiction fed. My life was unmanageable and completely out of control. For so long, I have looked for people, places, and things to fulfill my life and provide happiness, and I never could find it. I was so lost in my sin. I have a daughter that was adopted at a young age because of my addiction and bad choices. I have watched her grow up in pictures, and this is my greatest regret. My heart remains heavy that I have not been there for her. When I looked in the mirror, I saw failure and realized I had failed at everything in my


Wheels to WORK
